



Latrobe Regional Gallery offers a variety of free activities for families of all ages throughout the year. Families who may not have experienced a gallery before are encouraged to visit and chat to the friendly staff who will be happy to provide information on exhibitions and programs.

Children are very curious and imaginative, so the gallery is a fantastic free day out for families who want to explore their creative side. The gallery has available free **Art Trail** and **Art Cart** activities where families can explore the gallery together and are encouraged to look at artworks and create fantastic stories about what they see, how the artist might have created the work, or what the artwork means to them. There are no right or wrong answers in art, so this activity is a great introduction to art for both children and parents.

The Latrobe Regional Gallery also has a range of reasonably priced family and children's programs throughout the year. These include **School Holiday Workshops** which are held each school holidays with morning or afternoon sessions available for families with children aged 3 to 6 years, and children aged 7 to 12 years. More intensive 9 week **Art After School** programs are available for children aged 7 to 12 years, **Creative Edge** programs are also available for teenagers aged 13 to 16 years, and both are held during School Terms 1, 2 and 3. These programs do cost money, so please contact the gallery for more information.
